Don Viejo, son of Don Agustín, followed in his father's footsteps at an early age – and in doing so developed his own strength and uniqueness. His ceremonies are characterized by powerful chants, healing energies, and intense transformation.

His partner **Nina Caspi** also accompanies the ceremonies with great dedication. Her work is symbolic of the feminine essence – which brings light into the darkness.

Day 2-8: Mon-Sun, December 8-14, 2025 · Rituals & Healing Arts at the "Supaychacra" Camp

Intensive retreat week with:

- 3 Ayahuasca ceremonies (in the evening)
- · Plant baths & cleansing rituals
- Rapé ceremony
- Energy massages
- Daily discussions & exchanges in the group
- Time for rest, reflection, and nature

Day 9: Mon, Dec. 15, 2025 · Camp change to Don Agustin

Transfer: Supaychacra → Charapamama

Welcome and meet Don Agustín and Doña Marlene. Arrival, orientation, and evening gathering.

Days 10–12: Tue–Thu, December 16–18, 2025 · Ceremonies & Healing Rituals

- 2 Ayahuasca ceremonies (in the evening)
- Daily discussions and other healing rituals with Don Agustín & Doña Marlene

Day 13: Fri, Dec. 19, 2025 · Return to Iquitos

Departure from Camp Charapamama and Amazon boat trip back to Iquitos. Check-in at the hotel (organize yourself), free evening.

Day 14: Sat, Dec. 20, 2025 · Belén Medicine Market & Conclusion

Visit to the Belén medicine market with Laura, Alex, and herbalist Elisabeth.

Opportunity to purchase traditional medicinal products such as rapé, mapachos, agua de Florida, sananga, sangre de grado, and more.

In the evening, farewell dinner together in Iquitos.

- 5 ayahuasca ceremonies with Don Agustín, Doña Marlene, Don Viejo, and Nina Caspi
- Plant baths
- Parasite cleansing
- Shamanic rituals with or without plants
- Energy and healing work (individual and group rituals)
